Business

For students who are interested in a career in the Business sector (trade and commerce, finance and insurance, accounting, real estate, marketing, information technology, and more) this Specialist High Skills Major offers students a solid foundation in the area of study. The required SHSM credits, sector specific cooperative education opportunities, along with specialized sector training and certification are available for students to further expand their learning experiences.

Hospitality & Tourism

This Specialist High Skills Major (SHSM) program is designed for students interested in a career in one of the over 400 hundred occupations in the Hospitality and Tourism sector. Hospitality and Tourism jobs provide plenty of opportunities for advancement, widely transferable skills, and ongoing training.
